☐ Trainers will ensure that students are participating in 20 hours of fulltime study per week by calling students and tracking the

activity/ assessments given to students who are doing online/distance learning

The flexible arrangements to support students includes but is not limited to:

☐ Studying Online or distance learning remotely. ☐ Telephonic assistance or electronic assistance. ☐ Providing students with additional academic resources (like books, handouts) on request, this will help students to understand components of the units as well as undertake learnings of the topics thoroughly




☐ With flexible arrangements in place, students can also apply for:

Deferment or suspension of student's enrolment (case by case basis).

☐ Financial support: this includes making a new payment plan as per student's needs

☐ Students must call or book an appointment with the trainers/assessors if they are facing issues or difficulties.
